

Frequently Asked Questions.

1) What is the nature of this contest?

This event is named the HTML Programming Contest. This is a contest exclusively for school students who have knowledge in HTML, CSS, and JavaScript. The idea behind this contest is to help them portray their programming and coding skills.

2) Why is this event important for students?

This event is important for students who have knowledge of coding and programming as this could be the best ever platform to showcase their talents. It might help them get recognized and probably take their career to a whole different level.

3) Who can participate in this contest?

School students from Class 04 to Class 12 can participate in the contest. However, precise knowledge of the programming languages HTML, CSS & JavaScript is required in order to code the website.

4) How to register for the contest?

5) Is there a fee structure for the contest?

Yes, there is a registration fee of Rs 300 which should be paid by the participants in order to participate in the contest.

6) Where does the student come to participate while coding the website?

The participant will be given a theme for the project. The student should code the website which will represent the theme and then share it before the code submission day. The student can come to our office and utilize the computers here or they can code the website from anywhere in the world. All they need is to send their code through email or they can visit our office and submit the code in a pendrive.

7) Can the participants cancel their registration once the payment is done?

Sorry, the registration cannot be cancelled once the payment is done nor transferred to the name of another student. The registration charges are also not refundable.

8) What does the participant get from competing in this contest?

The participants are given a golden opportunity to showcase their coding talent. This will add to the self confidence levels of the participant. Contests are similar to examinations where competition is persistent with only a single winner in most cases. We believe that contests are equally important for children to boost up their determination.

9) How does this become helpful for the school?

This contest is focused on the educational institutions and the credits of any educational event the student participates in will go to the school on behalf of which the student is participating. Hence, this contest will be helpful for the school in terms of branding.

10) Why should I enroll my son/daughter for this contest?

If your child is well equipped with programming skills, do not keep them under the radar. Let them utilize this opportunity to identify their potentials. And if they excel in this contest, scholarships or cash prizes and recognitions await to help them pursue what they love.

11) What is the prize for the winner in this contest?

The winner will get a Trophy titled “The Winner of HTML Programming Contest - School Students 2018” and a cash prize (Scholarships are not confirmed as the sponsors for scholarships are yet to approve).

Cash Prize Details.

- a) Winner - Rs. 3,000/- (Rupees Three Thousand Cash).
- b) 1st Runner - Rs. 2,000/- (Rupees Two Thousand Cash).
- c) 2nd Runner - Rs. 1,000 /- (Rupees One Thousand Cash).

12) My child is studying in 10th standard but doesn't know HTML. Can he/ she enroll for the contest?

No, the student cannot enroll for the contest this year. However, the student can learn these languages within a year and prepare to participate in the next year's contest. The student will have an ample amount of time and can master the languages within a year.

13) My child knows HTML, CSS &JavaScript but he is pursuing his degree or is above 18 years. Can he/she participate in the event?

This event is being conducted for school students and we have 03 categories charted out based on the participant's current grade of education. However, your son/ daughter can enroll and create a website which we shall showcase during the contest, but as a student not as a participant which means his / her codes won't be considered for the contest. The registration is free for this type of enrollment.

14) Can I help my son/daughter while coding?

Yes, definitely. The participants need your help in coding the website, but when it comes to designing the website the code should be written only by the participants. The codes written by each participant will be reviewed by the panel of judges before the contest day.
